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

Our Program

PREPARATION FOR WORK

The Ready for Work Program was initiated in 2018 and consists of seven modules which address the most important steps related to the job application and interview process. It offers participants an opportunity to develop the skills required to successfully apply for and secure gainful employment or to further their secondary studies.

Although not included in the 6-day course, additional modules in the Program are:

- Job Board (Facebook/In-Centre)
- Work Experience
- Computer Training for ages 30 to 50 (60 minute lessons)

COLLABORATION

SR TAFE Harvey, Harvey Senior High Secondary School Engagement Program (SSEP) and atWork Australia are collaborating and supporting our introductory program to prepare their participants to enter/re-enter the workforce with improved skills and job prospects or to confidently continue their studies.
